### How to Place an Order

CIO-SP3 Small Business contract holders undergo a rigorous source selection process prior to award, during which NITAAC evaluates bidders' qualifications, including technical capabilities, past performance, price and cost. NITAAC also negotiates contract ceiling rates at the master contract level in order to ensure the best value to the government for all work bid through CIO-SP3 Small Business.

Because NITAAC takes the time to carefully evaluate firms and negotiate attractive rates, government programs using CIO-SP3 Small Business can solicit bids for task order-specific work from a field of companies already prequalified to do comparable work, knowing the work bid will be at a competitive price. This saves the government time, money and resources.

As a government agency, for you to use the CIO-SP3 Small Business vehicle, once your request for proposals (RFP) is ready, upload it into the secure, web-based electronic-Government Ordering System (e-GOS). e-GOS includes built in Federal Acquisition Regulation (FAR) guidance for automated task order competition, management, awardee selection and notification. Requests for information (RFI) and questions and answers (Q&As) can be managed through the system.

Once you submit your task order requirements through NITAAC, its contract specialists will perform a comprehensive assessment for scope, clarity and other factors within 24 hours to assure qualified responses.
